The National University of Ostroh Academy invites you to take part in the VIII International Scientific and Practical Conference “Education and Science in the Field of National Security: Development Problems and Priorities”, which will be held on November 6, 2026 at the National University of Ostroh Academy.

We invite doctors and candidates of sciences, doctoral students, PhD students, master’s students and representatives of public organizations (within the problem field of the conference) to participate in the conference. Participation of higher education students and PhD students is possible only with agreement of (or in cooperation with) scientific supervisor.

Participation in the conference is free.

Venue: Ukraine, Rivne region, Ostroh, Seminarska, 2. Old academic building of the National University of Ostroh Academy.

The conference begins at 10:00 a.m. on November 6, 2026

The duration of the report is up to 10 minutes.

Working languages: Ukrainian and English.

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Following the event, conference proceedings will be published, and certificates of participation will be issued to all participants.

Requirements for report preparation

- The abstracts of the report should be on a relevant topic, contain the results of scientific research, be edited and neatly formatted.
- The volume of the report (thesis of the speech) is up to 3 pages in A4 format (297x210 mm), book orientation. Margins: top – 15, bottom – 15, right – 15, left – 20, Font – Times New Roman, pin – 12, paragraph indent – 1 cm, line spacing – 1, style – Normal.
- First line – author's last name, first name and patronymic (regular font, bold, aligned on the right side of the page). Second line – academic degree, academic title, position, place of work (regular font, italic, aligned on the right side of the page). Third line – author's e-mail. For students/postgraduate students, information about the scientific supervisor must also be provided in a similar manner.
- The next paragraph, after a blank line, should contain the title of the report in large capital letters (regular font, bold, centered). Next, after a blank line, you should place the text of the report, aligned to the width of the page, paragraph – 10 mm.
- Writing thesis of the report does not involve using references to sources and creating a bibliographic list.
- Mandatory distinction between hyphens (-) and dashes (–); use of quotation marks of the format “”.
- It is forbidden to use the tab sign (Tab key) or multiple spaces to create paragraph, as well as to place figures, tables, diagrams, maps, charts, etc. in the text.
- Double spaces are prohibited. A non-breaking space should be placed between the initials and the surname (I. H. Ivanenko). Each abbreviation must be entered in the text in parentheses after the first mention of the corresponding full phrase and only then can it be used.
- Pages do not need to be numbered.
- The name of the file should correspond to the surname and name of the conference participant in Latin (for example, Mykola Romanov.Thesis).

The content of the thesis must correspond to the conference theme. Otherwise, the conference organizing committee will not consider the materials and will not return them to the authors.

Authors must adhere to the principles of academic integrity, the use of AI-generated content must be recorded (recommended tool for labeling the use of AI: <https://panbibliotekar.github.io/gaidet-declaration/index-uk.html>). Violation of these principles is grounds for refusal to publish thesis. All works will be checked for plagiarism (no more than 30%) and the use of AI.

The texts of the reports will be published in the author's version. The authors, as well as the scientific supervisors (for higher education applicants), are responsible for the scientific content, the quality of the submitted materials and the facts presented and compliance with the principles of academic integrity.

Texts that reveal critical violations of the above requirements will be rejected.
